

Niagara's Black History Tour



Explore Niagara's Outdoor Museum of Freedom Seekers!

Your tour guide for this tour is Niagara Bound Tours' owner, Lezlie Harper, a descendant of Freedom Seekers that came to Canada. So as well as the history, personal and family stories are also told.

The tour covers history from the 18th century to the 20th century. Sites of famous people are also visited such as Harriet Tubman, Josiah Henson (Uncle Tom's Cabin book), Anthony Burns as well as others that visited Niagara are mentioned.

After visiting three sites in Fort Erie, your guide's hometown, we travel along the beautiful Niagara Parkway to a hot lunch.

After lunch, it is time to go to St. Catharines have a tour of the church that Harriet Tubman helped to build and worshipped in. There are also two more sites regarding Black history in this area.

Before returning to the hotel, we will drive through Niagara on the Lake that was the first in the British Commonwealth to start the abolition of slavery. Again travelling the Niagara River route where your guide will point out other sites of interest on our way back to the hotel.
