Supreme Court Update on Police Cases

Melissa Arbus Sherry is a partner with Latham & Watkins in the Washington, D.C. office. She is the local Co-chair of the Litigation Department and a member of Latham & Watkins' Supreme Court and Appellate Practice. Ms. Sherry returned to Latham's Washington, D.C. office in October 2014 after serving five years as an Assistant to the Solicitor General of the United States. In this role, Ms. Sherry represented the federal government before the Supreme Court and assisted in overseeing the government's litigation in the federal appellate courts. Ms. Sherry has worked extensively with federal government agencies and various components within the Department of Justice. Ms. Sherry has argued ten cases before the Supreme Court and drafted more than a hundred briefs before the Court.

Following her graduation from law school, Ms. Sherry served as a law clerk to Justice John Paul Stevens, and to Judge Diana Gribbon Motz of the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit.
